About the Courses

All courses are taught at a level accessible to students in the exact, life, human and sociocultural evolutionary sciences. Students of evolutionary biology, microbiology, paleontology, evolutionary linguistics, evolutionary anthropology, and philosophy of biology will especially benefit from these courses.

You are free to either enroll for a specific module (and therefore to follow a 30-hour course on the subject taught by 3 teachers) or you may choose to enroll for 3 specific courses (10 hours per course), regardless the module they are classified in.

Enrollment and registration

The School is open to International Master, PhD and Post-doctoral students. Registration is continuously open from **January 7th**, until **May 31st, 2013**.

The registration fee is **350 euro**. Travel and accommodation are not included. **FCUL students** can enroll at the reduced fee of **200 euro**.
