The project

Eco2Wine is a collaborative project involving 21 organisations aiming to train a new generation of PhD graduates capable of managing winemaking-associated ecosystems. This initiative focuses on safeguarding biodiversity, minimising unsustainable interventions, and promoting sustainability in wine production. The project encompasses various disciplines, such as environmental science, biotechnology, viticulture, microbiology, economics, and social sciences, to foster a holistic understanding of wine ecosystems. This initiative seeks to advance wine research, benefit winemakers, and engage a diverse group of stakeholders in the wine industry.

The offer

10 PhD positions are available, each aligned with specific research projects, exploring topics ranging from grapevine biocontrol agents to microbial interactions in winemaking and from wine marketing to science communication. The selected candidates will benefit from a competitive salary, a stimulating internal training programme, access to state-of-the-art research facilities, and the opportunity to work on groundbreaking projects with real-world impact.

Eligibility and selection procedure

Applicants must meet eligibility criteria, including not possessing a doctoral degree at the expected recruitment date and having limited residency in the country where the research project occurs. The selection process adheres to the European Charter for researchers and includes evaluation based on academic records, publications, and a statement of motivation. Shortlisted candidates will undergo interviews and may be required to present their master’s research. The Eco2Wine partners subscribe to equal opportunity employment, with no restrictions based on gender, age, ethnicity, or other factors.
